ON-SITE REGISTRATION:

On-site registration is located inside the Oregon Convention Center in Exhibit Hall B.

• Please note: You must show your identification to pick up your badge on site. Students and K-12 teacher registrants, reminder that you will need to show your school identification to pick up your badge, as well.

• To order tickets for meal functions and special events, please visit the ASEE Registration desk located in the convention center, Exhibit Hall BCD. Tickets will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis. Please note that on-site ticket sales close the day before the event takes place. Be sure to register early, as space is limited. Tickets are also available on-line, as well.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION IN Portland

Transportation

The center is eight miles from <u>Portland International Airport (PDX)</u>, attendees can access the Oregon Convention Center (OCC) via Interstate 5 North from Exit 302A–Rose Quarter, or from Interstate 84 West Exit 1–Lloyd Boulevard.

Portland's <u>TriMet</u> MAX light rail stops 300 times a day at the center's front door, connecting attendees to downtown, surrounding neighborhoods, and <u>Portland International Airport</u>.

TriMet's Bus Line No. 6 also stops at the MLK Lobby entrance and provides access to downtown stops and outlying areas.

Portland is served by many excellent taxi, shuttle, car rental, and on-street carsharing and ridesharing services. Please search online for your preferred option.

Parking: Onsite parking is provided in the convention center's underground garage. You may enter the garage through either the NE Lloyd Blvd (P1) or NE First Avenue (P2) entrances. Clearance on the P1 Level is 7 feet; clearance on the P2 Level is 9 feet. The center has a total of 800 spaces.

Standard Daily Parking Rate: \$12

The garage generally opens daily at 6:00 am.

Please allow for ample time to park. The garage can reach capacity on days with busy <u>event schedules</u> and area traffic may impact your arrival and departure times. On these days we recommend using public or commercial transportation. Alternative transit information is provided below. The Oregon Convention Center does not guarantee parking availability. Availability is on a first come, first served basis.

The center is a cashless venue. To provide a faster, more efficient transaction process, they only accept credit/debit cards and touchless payment methods.

The pay-on-foot parking kiosk at the South Ginko entrance accepts both cash and credit card payments.

There are also 566 metered parking spaces within three blocks of the OCC. Short term drop-off/pick-up zones are available adjacent to the convention center on NE Martin Luther King, Jr. (MLK) Boulevard and on NE Holladay Street.

All drop-off and loading zones are located on an accessible route to an accessible building entrance and have adequate vertical and horizontal clearance. Not all zones have an unobstructed aisle next to the vehicle pull-up space. There is a public-use sidewalk, which may be obstructed by pedestrians and attendees.

Portland Streetcar

Getting around the City is made easy via the Portland Streetcar. <u>Portland Streetcar's</u> Central Loop stops at our MLK Lobby entrance every 15 minutes.

Complimentary passes will be available for staff and attendees at the hotel front desk when checking in and at the info kiosk. The passes will be valid June 22 – 27 and can be used on all forms of public transportation including the MAX light rail, streetcar, and bus systems.

What to Wear

Portland's weather average daily high temperatures increase from 71°F to 78°F in June, so please dress accordingly when outdoors. Be advised that meeting rooms have a tendency to be cool, so light jackets/sweaters/layers are recommended
