

Benefits and Structure of ASEE Corporate Membership

Long-Term Benefits of Membership

ASEE corporate membership provides organizations with lasting advantages. First, members remain informed about the latest trends and developments in engineering education by engaging with top educators and administrators. This connection helps them stay up to date on industry advancements and emerging best practices. Second, corporate members can influence student learning directly by providing input on curriculum and research, ensuring that educational programs align with industry needs, preparing students for real-world challenges, and fostering innovation in the workforce. Third, membership supports the development of future engineering talent. Active involvement in ASEE initiatives helps nurture and shape future engineers, enhancing the organization's long-term capabilities and benefiting the wider engineering community.

Corporate Member Council

Corporate and non-academic ASEE members can appoint a "Key Contact" to represent their organization on the <u>Corporate Member Council</u> (CMC). The CMC functions as a collaboration platform between academia and industry, promoting partnerships that support engineering education. The council meets twice a year and organizes additional events, providing ongoing opportunities to engage with leaders in engineering education.

Membership Tiers

ASEE provides two main levels of membership for organizations, distinguished by size:

Standard Membership: Suitable for companies with 100 or more employees, non-profits with 25 or more staff, and government agencies. Standard members can assign up to

three Contact Members: A Key Contact for the Corporate Member Council and three other representatives. All contacts enjoy full ASEE benefits at no extra charge. The annual fee is \$1,670.

Affiliate Membership: For smaller organizations with fewer than 100 employees, or non-profits with under 25 staff. Each affiliate member selects one representative for the Corporate Member Council who can access ASEE membership benefits individually. The annual fee is \$402.

Optional Added Membership Benefit

Both standard and affiliate corporate members can opt to join ASEE's <u>Engineering Research Council</u> (ERC) for an extra annual fee. The ERC includes engineering faculty, research administrators, and representatives from corporations and government agencies who manage and fund federal research grants for engineering colleges. The yearly additional fee is \$175.45.

Immediate Membership Benefits for Representatives

When a representative joins, they immediately gain several benefits: an online subscription to ASEE PRISM, a quarterly magazine with diverse engineering and technology topics; access to ASEE's peer-reviewed quarterly Journal of Engineering Education; secure login to members-only website sections, including the electronic directory and PRISM archives; discounted registration for the ASEE Annual Conference & Exposition and other ASEE events; eligibility to join any of ASEE's 56 professional interest divisions; and unlimited networking through conferences and regional activities. Additionally, member organizations receive discounts on exhibit space and advertising in ASEE PRISM.
